NEDLAC EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING WITH MINISTER JOEMAT-PETTERSON

The Nedlac Executive Council is Nedlac's highest decision maker body. It consists of the leaders of Nedlac's four social partners - organised Business, organised Labour, the Community constituency and Government. The Exco meets 4 times a year to discuss high level policy issues.

The last Exco meeting of 2014 was held at Gallagher Estate on 4 December 2014. The focus of yesterday's meeting was on energy. Minister Tina Joemat-Petterson presented the Department of Energy's "Energy Intervention Strategy" to the Exco.

The Minister acknowledged the severe energy challenges that were being faced by the country. She called on social partners to work together to forge solutions to the country's energy constraints, and to work in partnership with government to this end.

The Minister committed to tabling a range of energy initiatives for engagement at Nedlac. Nedlac s Energy Task Team, which reports to the Nedlac Management Committee, would then engage on these matters.
