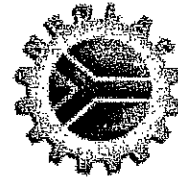

ANNEXURE 1

1. Having noted that:

1.1 On the 23rd September 2015 COSATU submitted a Section 77 (1) (d) showing its intention to proceed with a socioeconomic strike on the state of Public Transport in South Africa on the 7th October 2015.

1.2 In its 23rd September 2015 application COSATU indicated that following the socioeconomic strike on the 7th October 2015, the Federation will assess the programme of action and decide on the way forward. It also indicated that it reserves the right to extend the programme of action should this be necessary.

1.3 The strike went ahead but the issues COSATU raised stand unresolved and government has shown commitment to continue with the same transport system and implementation of the e-tolling system.

2. COSATU will be calling upon all workers to support a further socioeconomic protest action by engaging in various forms of protest.

2.1 The forms of protest action and action in contemplation of and furtherance of the protest action will involve:

2.1.1 Work stoppages (socioeconomic strike)

2.1.2 Rallies, marches, demonstrations, pickets (including lunchtime pickets), placards demonstrations, siyalalas both national and provincial from the 30th September 2016.

2.1.3 Engagement of motorists and other members of public to inform them of the reasons for the protest action and to persuade them to support the action.

3. The protest actions that will involve time away from work are:

3.1 Rallies, marches, demonstrations, pickets (including lunchtime pickets), placards demonstrations, siyalalas at or near the offices the premises of National Department of Transport (NDOT) and SANRAL, both national and provincial on the 7th October 2016.

3.2 A national stay away or a socioeconomic strike on the 7th October 2016.

4. The specific activities in paragraph 3.2 will take place during working hours. The socioeconomic strike will commence at 00h00 and end at 24h00 on 7th October 2016 except that shift workers will be away for the duration of one whole shift and it will be the shift that has the majority of hours on the day in question.

5. Following the socioeconomic strike on the 7th October 2016, the Federation will assess the programme of action and decide on the way forward. It reserves the right to extend the programme of action should this be necessary.
